Tuesday, February 2nd is the feast of St. Blaise. Blessing of Throats will be given at 8am mass.

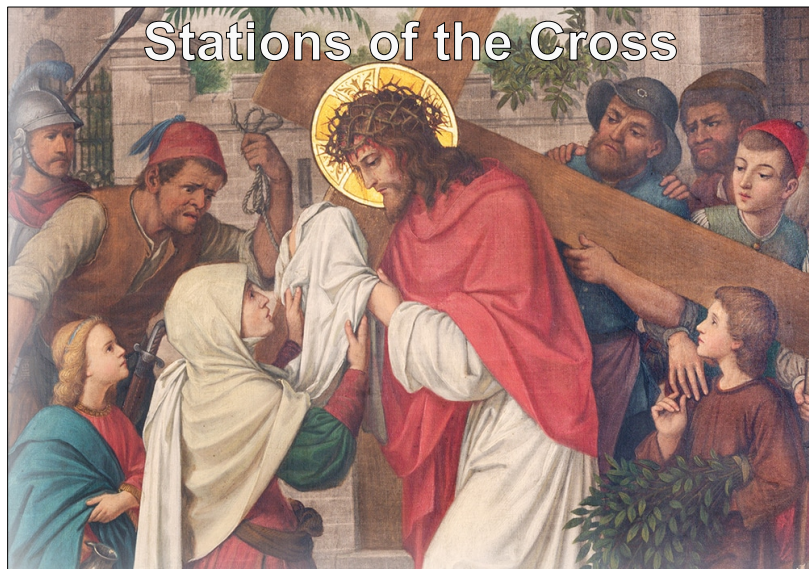
